THE WICKED PROBLEM

Youth unemployment is on the increase in Nigeria. Akwa Ibom State has the highest youth unemployment rate in the country. In Uyo(Akwa Ibom State, about 5 out of every young person aged 15-35 years are unemployed. If not addressed, in the near future, ther will be an upsurge of crime, illegal migrations and a stunted national economy and development, amongst several unpleasant outcomes.

MEET PRECIOUS

Precious is 23 years old. She is the 4th child of 5 siblings. Two of her elder brothers have a degrees from one of the Universities in Nigeria but have been unemployed for more than 3 years. Her immediate elder sister teachers at a secondary school in their community with a salary below \$80 per month. Precious's Father earns about \$200 every month from his Bank job. Her mother owns a petty provision store in the the street where they live.

Due to the harsh economic situation in their family, Precious had not been able to get a university degree, even though her elder ones cant find a good paying job with their degrees. For this reason, Precious's biggest dream is to learn vocational skills to enable her set up her own business, so she can make enough money to take care of herself and support her struggling family, but the barriers of tuition and business capital had crippled her dreams for years.

Yet, Precious is not the only one with a crippled dream. In Uyo(Nigeria), there are about 5 Precious in every 10 person aged 15-35years.

Uyo(Nigeria) has a total population of about 1.28million. Over 65% of the entire State population is below the age of 35years.

Of the above number, our initial target will be on adolescent and young people aged 15-24 years from low resource families in Uyo, who have no job nor skills. This number is estimated between 50-120,000.

In addition, we will also target funders that fund education and development projects in Nigeria. This number is estimated at 25 at the moment with the possibility of discovering more funders as we develop our project further.
