CONFERENCE FOCUS AREAS

Giving Back. In this content area, the sessions will center on service, community engagement, and staying connected to nuestra gente as a young professional.

Currently, La Conferencia is the only conference that allows members of the Latinx community and its allies to meet and discuss the lived experiences of Latinx people in the South across multiple sectors in our state. It is our opportunity to remind our audience that our voices are essential to the story of North Carolina. We see it as our responsibility to pick keynote speakers who are local Latinx leaders to reflect this important value to our attendees.

Each year the keynote was chosen based on their alignment of that year's conference theme. The speaker(s) has highlighted the essence of being Latinx in North Carolina, while also providing community support through advocacy, educational initiatives, or contributions to our community's well-being. For future conferences, our hope is to continue to invite presenters who illuminate the power of Latinx people in North Carolina.

PAST CONFERENCES OVERVIEW

LA CONFERENCIA 2021



In March 2021, we hosted the inaugural session of La Conferencia using the theme of La Nueva Era, The New Era. Originally planned to be an in-person opportunity for connecting and sharing knowledge, we were able to pivot to a virtual platform. We created two days for Latinx students, staff, faculty, and their allies to network and create a discourse about access, social development, education, positive communication, and cross-cultural understanding in a Latinx-centered setting.

We had 116 registrants and representation from undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty members, staff members, and community members. Our keynote speaker was Irene Godínez, founder and executive director of Poder NC. The main words used from our attendees to describe their experience at La Conferencia was **supported** and **inspired**.

LA CONFERENCIA 2022



In April 2022, the Carolina Latinx Center hosted La Conferencia 2022 using the theme of Pa'Lante, Moving Forward. The conference was held in a virtual format and it took place across three days, Day 1 and Day 3 of the conference focused on community building at an outdoor baseball game and playing a virtual game. Day 2 of the conference gave Latinx students, staff, faculty, and their allies the space to discuss topics related to identity, mental health, career development, and financial advancement.

Our keynote speaker was Ricky Hurtado, a UNC alumn and the first Democrat candidate elected to the NC State House. Additionally, we had 25 presenters discussing diverse topics affecting the Latinx community in the Triangle. In our second year of La Conferencia, we looked for ways to grow our reach across the state.


LA CONFERENCIA 2023
