Example Script:

1. **Intros** (if needed, e.g., “ _____ will be taking notes”)

2. **Purpose.** The purpose of today’s interview is to get *your perspective on our training programs*. We will use the information from our interviews to design program evaluations that cover the necessary elements for our doctoral and postdoctoral trainees across clinical, biomedical, and biological sciences at UNC. As a reminder, everything you say will be kept confidential. Any findings will be disseminated in aggregate form and nothing you say will be attributed to you by name. Your participation is entirely voluntary and you may stop participating or leave at any time.

 - a. What are appropriate/relevant program activities that should be included in a program from your perspective?
 - b. What are appropriate/relevant program assessments that should be included in a program?
 - c. In your experience, what metrics or outcomes are typically evaluated well by programs?
 - d. Are there metrics or outcomes that are not commonly evaluated that you think should be included?
 - e. In what ways could effective T32 program evaluation impact or inform national policy?

WRAP UP (5 minutes):
