I. BACKGROUND

On November 11, 2009, Plaintiffs, Zach Dexter and Saang M. Lee, filed a complaint against the Speaker of Student Congress, Joseph Levin-Manning, contesting "the validity of [Congress's] vote on SCB-91-60." Plaintiffs also filed a motion for a temporary injunction requesting that the Chief Justice (1) enjoin Defendant from distributing the bill to the Student Body President Jasmine Jones or (2) enjoin President Jones from signing SCB-91-60 into law if Defendant had already submitted SCB-91-60 to her. Because President Jones is not a defendant in this matter, she may not be enjoined from signing the bill. Though Defendant has already distributed SCB-91-064 to her, President Jones has neither signed nor vetoed SCB-91-60 into law.

II. ORDER

Accordingly, Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary injunction is DENIED.

Plaintiffs are hereby GRANTED leave to submit an amended complaint to the Court, on or before 5 pm on Wednesday, November 18, 2009, naming President Jones as a defendant.
