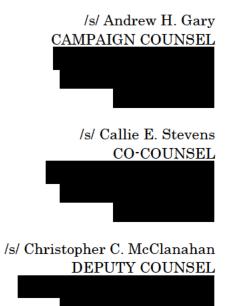
MOTION
