

TRANSITIONAL COUNCIL MEMORANDUM NUMBER 1

IMPLEMENTATION OF ORDER NUMBER 1 (TC/ORD/DD MM 2023)

Pursuant to the authority vested in this Council by the Constitution of the Student Body,

Recalling that the Constitution of the Student Body charges this body with “setting the size of The Senate for the 2024 Session”,

Having considered several proposals regarding the size of the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Body,

Guided by the principles of fair representation,

Implementing TC Order No. 1, The Composition of the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Body,

The following is hereby promulgated:

Section 1 Apportionment of Seats

- 1) This Memorandum describes how the immediate implementation of Order No. 1 is to be carried out.
- 2) The Board of Elections is directed to use the following formula when applying the Huntington Hill Method:

$$S_d = \begin{cases} \lceil \frac{P_d}{300} \rceil & \text{if } \frac{P_d}{300} > \sqrt{\lfloor \frac{P_d}{300} \rfloor (\lfloor \frac{P_d}{300} \rfloor + 1)} \\ \lfloor \frac{P_d}{300} \rfloor & \text{if } \frac{P_d}{300} \leq \sqrt{\lfloor \frac{P_d}{300} \rfloor (\lfloor \frac{P_d}{300} \rfloor + 1)} \end{cases}$$
